Dr. Khoo completed his Internal Medicine Training at the University of Toronto in 2008 and went on to the University of BC where he completed his Cardiology Training in 2011. He continued at the University of BC where he completed a two year fellowship in Electrophysiology at St. Paul's Hospital.
